



INDIAN HILLS TREE PLANTING PROGRAM 2017



The City of Indian Hills, Councilwoman Angela Leet and Councilman Scott Reed are excited to announce a cooperative first year initiative to restore our tree canopy by increasing the number of shade trees along streets throughout our community.

The benefits are numerous, ranging from increased property value, reduced energy cost, greater diversity of tree species and the chance to leave a lasting legacy for future generations.

Your comprehensive Tree Planting Program package will include:

- **One (1) tree at match cost – you pay half and we pay half**
- 1-1 consultation with Mike Hayman, Certified Arborist who will assist with tree selection and location
- Tree delivery & planting; watering bag, stakes, deer protection wire and tree labels
- Training on proper planting and care
- Ongoing care reminders and future pruning workshop opportunities
- Tree evaluations for the first couple of years to let you know how your trees are doing

How does the program work? We are offering twenty (20) trees (5 spectacular species) that will be available through a drawing. *Twenty (20) applications will be drawn by Mayor Chip Hancock and Metro Councilwoman Angela Leet; five (5) from each of the four (4) sections in Indian Hills. The drawing will take place on Sunday October 1, 2017 at the Indian Hills Oktoberfest Celebration (you do not have to be present to win).*

Participation is **voluntary** and you do not have to accept a tree you do not want. This program is open only to owner occupants of detached single family homes. Plantings will take place in the latter part of this year and payment will be due 3 weeks prior to planting.

If you are interested in participating in this program, please read the following instructions and complete the attached application:

Match Cost Planting

- This program is a shared expense between the resident and the City of Indian Hills. **You agree to pay half the cost of a tree**, which varies by the tree chosen (*choices listed on reverse*). The City of Indian Hills pays the other half and the cost of planting, the water bag, stakes, wire, designation tags and 1-1 consultation with an arborist to assist you in choosing the tree and location.
- Presently, there are a total of 20 trees that will be divided between the 4 sections.
- This program is limited to one (1) tree per household of owner occupied, detached single family homes.
- The tree must be planted in the front yard.
- Species available for this program are limited to the 5 trees chosen by the arborist.
