TRASH COLLECTION:

Residents are reminded to be considerate of their neighbors and mindful of the city's appearance by not putting out garbage, recycling, and yard waste containers until Tuesday night ... and retrieving them by day's end on Wednesday.

ALL PICK UPS ARE ON WEDNESDAYS

GARBAGE is picked up in the **REAR OF YOUR PROPERTY**

RECYCLING and **YARDWASTE** are picked up at **CURBSIDE** (YARDWASTE is by individual subscription)

GARBAGE - Up to three 32 gallon cans of garbage will be picked up in the rear of your home. Any amount over three cans must be taken to the street for pickup. Eco-Tech will collect one large item in addition to the regular household trash. Examples include unwanted furniture, appliances (except for refrigerators), etc. These types of “junk” should be taken to the street the night before pickup (preferably after dark). If you have old carpeting or padding, tie in bundles of no more than 4 feet in length, and place curbside.

Eco-Tech does not furnish any garbage containers as part of their disposal contract. You may use a garbage bin of up to 95 gallons (maximum loaded weight of 75 pounds), but any bins larger than 32 gallons must be taken to the curb. These may be purchased at many retail outlets, or purchased or rented from Eco-Tech.

“Good To Know” – Keep Handy For Reference

RECYCLING - Bins are provided by Eco-Tech and are to be placed curbside. Be sure to use the lids provided to keep paper from scattering. Following is Eco-Tech's basic list of recyclable items: Plastic bottles #1-7, Glass bottles and jars, Steel food cans, Aluminum cans, Newspaper, Cardboard (broken down into 3' x 3' or less bundles) - no greasy pizza boxes, Paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes), Office paper, Printer's scrap, Magazines, Phone books. Please separate paper products from the rest of the materials using paper bags.

Remember to rinse all food residue from recycling items. Eco-Tech cannot recycle items that have food particles or are soiled by food residue. Labels need not be removed from bottles, jars, or cans.

HOLIDAYS - Eco-Tech observes six holidays a year for residential customers; New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If our collection day falls on or after an observed holiday during that business week, i.e., Monday through Wednesday, that week's collection day will be postponed by one day to Thursday. If a holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, it does not affect the collection schedule unless the holiday is observed on Monday. Check the website for details on a specific holiday.

WEATHER DELAYS – In the event that inclement weather delays Eco-Tech's normal pick-up, notice to that effect will be placed on the Indian Hills website Bulletin Board.

YARD WASTE - Yard waste collection is provided on an **INDIVIDUAL SUBSCRIPTION BASIS** only. Subscribers will be invoiced directly by Eco-Tech. Eco-Tech is the only authorized residential sanitation company to operate in the City. This does not prevent you from having a landscaping service or yard service company. Eco-Tech provides for disposal only.

Eco-Tech will provide each subscription customer with a green, 95-gallon waste wheeler (trash can on wheels). Green cans are for yard waste only. The maximum weight in the green can is 75 pounds.

Yard waste will be collected each Wednesday from the beginning of March to the end of December. All yard waste and yard waste containers must be taken to the curb. Eco-Tech will service the green can and up to ten (10) paper yard waste bags per week. You may substitute standard 32-gallon trash cans for the bags if they are **CLEARLY MARKED** as yard waste. Acceptable yard waste items are grass clippings, leaves, brush, and other lawn vegetative matter. Large amounts of dirt or rock are not acceptable. Twigs that do not fit into the green can may be cut and bundled, not to exceed fifty (50) pounds. Cut twigs should be no longer than four (4) feet in length and three (3) inches in diameter. Branches and tree stumps are not acceptable.

To sign up for service call Eco-Tech at 935-1130. Major credit cards are accepted. Identify yourself as a resident of the City of Indian Hills. The fee for the ten months service period (July-December & March-June) is \$54.49 per our 2017-2018 contract. Pro-rated billing for partial year's service is not available.
