We are excited to have you participate. Please read the following instructions and feel free to ask any questions prior to completing and submitting the attached application below.

Costs are shared between the City and private property owners:

- This program is a shared expense between the resident and the City of Indian Hills. As in prior years, we expect the total cost to be about \$500. You agree to pay half the total cost of the tree & services provided (\$250.00) and the City pays the other half (\$250.00).
- We only have 20 trees to offer this year and they are available to any resident of the City of Indian Hills who owns a detached home and is a taxpayer.
- This program is limited to one tree per household. If you received a matching cost tree under a prior year's program, you are not eligible to enter for 2019. If you were not selected in prior years, submit a new application. Elected officials & Committee members are not eligible.
- The tree must be planted in the front yard to optimize canopy shade tree benefits.
- Species for this program are limited to the four (4) designated by the arborist. The choices are: Kentucky Coffee Tree, Tulip Poplar, Swamp White Oak or American Beech.
