## Waste Management (Item #3) on Agenda)

(a) 5.24.24 Addendum III Bid Results re rear door trash collection service limited to elderly, handicapped and residences with long driveways – Mayor Hancock gave the following 5.24.24 Addendum III bid results for monthly limited rear door service:

All prices bid are on a monthly charge and amount for rear door service would be invoiced directly to the resident.

The first two years of curbside service which will be paid by the city:

Eco-tech's bid - 24.15 per household x 1185 residences = 343,413 per year

Rumpke's bid - 25.50 per household x 1185 residences = 362,610 per year or rear door service 447,930 per year

(b) Discussion – The Council's concerns ranged from Eco-tech's bidding only up to 50 residences for rear door service to not offering to all residents due to the excess amount of \$105,000 over the curbside service, and that the city should not treat one resident differently from others. Following much discussion, Councilor Dunbar moved to accept Rumpke's curbside trash and recycling bids totaling \$25.50 per household per month from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026; and \$26.78 per household per month from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 to be paid by the city with limited rear door service offered to residents who are elderly, handicapped or who may have long driveways and require rear door service to be paid by the resident requiring rear door service and invoiced directly to resident by Rumpke. Motion seconded by Councilor Dreisbach; none opposed.

(a) Municipal Order No. 4, Series 2024 – Award of Garbage Collection Contract (07.01.2024 – 06.30.2028) Councilor Dunbar introduced, Attorney Cato read and Councilor Hayward moved to approve Municipal Order No. 4, Series 2024; seconded by Councilor Maddox.
